

Dress for Success Update – April 2018



The Impact100 WA grant is being used to develop the 'Going Places' Career Support Program. This involves the delivery by experienced facilitators of career support and employability workshops that will build the capacity of unemployed, under-employed and low-income women to secure and sustain employment. They also concurrently offer professional one-to-one styling and suiting for their clients.

In their latest progress report they say:

“We have hired our workshop co-ordinator, Jane McCormack, who was a volunteer and still volunteers extra hours to help out with the day to day running of Dress for Success Perth.

We launched the 'Going Places' Workshop Series back in January with a showcase to our referral agencies and up to the end of March 2018 we have held 8 workshops with 40 Participants.

Including our suiting and coaching services we have made an impact for 90 women so far this year and provided 122 items to our clients to enhance their employability.”



Their referral partners include: Workpower, Mission Providence, Outcare, Maxima, Zonta House Refuge, Communicare, ORS Group, Carers WA and Access Housing.
