

What is Impact100 WA? -- Impact100 WA changes how we lift up and transform our community by harnessing the power of collective giving.

How does it work?

At least 100 people donate \$1,000 each with the goal of significantly impacting at least one WA not-for-profit organisation through a donation of \$100,000.

What makes us different?

- We **introduced the first** Impact100 model to Australia in 2012
- We are WA focused only & support local, "mid-tier" not-for-profits in our community.
- Each donor can determine their preferred **level of engagement** throughout the year.
- Each donor has **one equal vote** to decide who receives the \$100,000 grants at the Grant Awards Dinner.
- **100% of every \$1000** donation goes towards the grants.
- **Strong due diligence** is conducted during the grant application & assessment process.

The concept is simple and powerful:







At least 100 people

Each donate \$1,000

To make transformative \$100,000 grants

Our impact since 2012

- **\$2,725,000** in direct grants by Impact100 WA
- To **45 different** local not-for-profit organisations
 - Plus at least **\$1.3m** in 'side' donations to some NFPs from our donors
- 27 transformational projects have proceeded after receiving a Primary Grant
- **32** Minor Grants have enabled capacity building
 - **84%** retention rate of donors to Impact100 WA
 - Therefore, more understanding of the issues, solutions & opportunities
 - And creating **3 x \$100k** grants in 2021, 2022 & 2023
 - YoungImpact has run for 9 years:
 - Over 60 young people have taken part
 - Raising over \$34,000 for 12 organisations
